Math Consultant

This consultant will be expected to develop intensive math curriculum for at-risk middle and high school students. The consultant will oversee all math improvement efforts. Applicant must be willing to travel extensively, including potential consecutive overnight travel. This is a full time position, minimum 210 day contract.

The successful applicant should possess the following:

- Rank I or equivalent (12 graduate hours in mathematics preferred)
- 10 years of classroom teaching experience preferred
- Documented evidence of students' progress
- Leadership experience
- Proficient technology skills
- Knowledge of issues and challenges affecting education in Kentucky
- Evidence of professional growth beyond that which is required for position

Applicants may be expected to:

- Submit a sample lesson plan;
- Submit a sample unit
- Present/teach a concept to a panel;
- Analyze test scores;
- Show evidence of presentation skills geared to adult learners
- Share documents developed as a consultant/conference presentations
